### Subject Stationery

- **Year 8 Technology** – 1 fine Artline pen
- **Year 8 Languages** (French or Japanese) - 1x White Board Maker and 1x Mini Whiteboard labelled with own name
- **Years 8 -10 English** – 1x48-page exercise book and earphones
- **Years 8-10 Mathematics** -Students require a calculator which they should still have from Year 7. IF students are needing to buy a new calculator, it is necessary they buy a CASIO fx-100AU PLUS 2<sup>nd</sup> Edition. There is no need to buy a new calculator if they currently own a different scientific calculator model from their previous high school years. However, NESA will soon make the decision that the CASIO fx-100AU PLUS 2<sup>nd</sup> Edition is the essential calculator that does necessary statistics that previous models do not.
- **Year 9 and 10 Japanese** – This is an elective subject and only applies to the Japanese students. 1x 5mm square grid exercise book approximately 100 pages (to replace lined exercise book), 1x White Board Maker and 1x Mini Whiteboard labelled with own name.
- **Year 9 and 10 French** – This is an elective subject and only applies to the French students. 1x White Board Maker and 1x Mini Whiteboard labelled with own name.
- **Year 9 NAPLAN** - Please note that Year 9 will require *plug in* (non-Bluetooth/wireless) earphones for NAPLAN testing – these do not need to be high quality.

It is recommended that all books are labelled and covered in contact as it provides longevity and durability to the books.

There may be additional stationery requirements for electives (Years 9 and 10) that will be given to the students upon return to school.
